Days 1 – 3: Day Camp at NCOAE Campus

Day 1 – Welcome to Adventure!

Drop-off: 9 a.m. | Pick-up: 4 p.m.

Kick off the week by meeting new friends and getting comfortable at NCOAE's Camp L.E.A.D. Pro (Learn. Explore. Adventure. Discover).

Highlights:

- Welcome, orientation, and icebreaker & leadership games
- Team-building challenges to build confidence and friendships
- Introduction to outdoor safety and adventure skills
- STEM in nature session (wildlife, ecosystems, or outdoor science fun)
- Camp games and afternoon reflection circle

Day 2 – Water, Science and Exploration

Drop-off: 9 a.m. | Pick-up: 4 p.m.

A full day blending outdoor science with water adventure.

Highlights:

- Canoeing and/or kayaking instruction and water safety
- Fun scavenger hunt challenges
- Introduction to geocaching (real GPS treasure hunting)
- Environmental science mini-lab outdoors
- Group leadership challenges and games

Day 3 – Coast Adventure + Overnight Prep

Drop-off: 9 a.m. | Pick-up: 4 p.m.

Exploration day with coastal discovery and preparation for camping.

Highlights:

- Carolina Beach State Park visit
- Aquarium exploration and coastal ecology learning
- Beachside arts and nature journaling
- Camp packing session and gear check for overnight trip
- Introduction to camp craft skills like tent setup and Leave No Trace

Days 4 – 6: Overnight Camping Adventure at a NC State Park

Day 4 – Into the Wild

The Camp L.E.A.D. Pro overnight adventure begins as campers head to a beautiful North Carolina state park.

Highlights:

- Travel to campsite and tent setup
 - Camp craft skills (stoves, knots, campsite organization)
 - Short hike and nature observation
 - Campfire, dinner, stories, and s'mores
 - Night games and stargazing
- Overnight camping begins.

Day 5 – Exploration and Camp Fun

Full day of outdoor adventure and leadership growth.

Highlights:

- Guided hiking and navigation skills using map & compass
- Environmental stewardship activity or service project
- Outdoor leadership challenges
- Camp games, free recreation time, and nature exploration
- Evening campfire, dinner, skits, and s'mores

Day 6 – Reflection & Return

Wrap up the adventure with new skills and friendships.

Highlights:

- Breakfast and campsite breakdown
- Reflection circle and leadership takeaway discussion
- Return travel to NCOAE campus
- Parent pick-up and celebration send-off*
